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PACT OF CO-RESPONSIBILITY BETWEEN BUDRIO'S BOARD OF EDUCATION AND FAMILIES OF CHILDREN ENROLLED IN NURSERY SCHOOLS

On organizational, sanitation measures and individual behavior aimed at containing the spread of Covid-19 contagion

**THEY SIGN THE FOLLOWING CO-RESPONSIBILITY PACT INHERENT
THE SCHOOL ATTENDANCE OF.....TO THE

In particular, the parent (or parenting responsibility holder) declares:

- The regularity of the vaccination coverage of the child for whom attendance is required for educational activities (L. n.119/2017);
- To be aware of COVID-19 infection containment measures in force on today's date;
- That, at the time of signing the pact, the child or a cohabitant within the family unit is not subject to the quarantine measure and is not test positive to COVID-19;
- to commit to keep their child at home in the presence of fever (equal to or greater than 37.5 degrees) or other symptoms such as coughing, headache, gastrointestinal symptoms, breathing difficulties, myalgia, nasal congestion, sore throat, conjunctivitis, loss of smell or taste and to promptly inform the pediatrician and the school through

the filling in the appropriate online form on the school's website, about the appearance of the above symptoms or fever (as indicated in the "*ISS COVID- 19 n.58/2020* report");

- To be aware and accept that, in the event of fever (temperature equal to or greater than 37.5 degrees) or symptoms (including those listed above), the school's staff provides for the isolation of the child and to immediately inform the family members. The physician/pediatrician of free choice will evaluate the case and will, if necessary, contact the Department of Public Health (DSP) for the expected investigations;

- To be aware and accept that, in the case of COVID-19 positivity, the child cannot be re-admitted to school until healing has fully occurred, certified according to the protocols provided;

- To have been adequately informed by the operators of the educational activities of all the organizational and sanitation provisions for safety and for the containment of the risk of spreading the contagion from Covid-19 and in particular the provisions for access and exit from the facility;

- To commit to adopting, even in the times and places of the day that their child does not spend in the educational facility, behaviors of maximum precaution about the risk of contagion;

- To be aware that at the time of a resumption of interaction activities, although controlled, it is not possible to eliminate the risk of contagion, which must be minimized through the scrupulous and rigorous observance of the precautionary and safety measures provided by special protocols for the conduct of activities; For this reason, it is important to observe the utmost caution even outside the context of educational activities; - to provide teachers with the contact details of adults of reference and to be available, if necessary, to withdraw their child from school in a short time;

- To commit to communicate any states of fragility of the child that exposes him most at risk of Covid 19 infection;

**In particular, the educational institution
declares:**

- To have adopted any organizational and sanitary provision in order to contain the spread of Covid-19 infection in accordance with current legislation and to provide families with adequate information on this issue;

- That for the realization of educational activities, it employs adequately trained staff on all aspects relating to sanitation procedures to combat the spread of contagion. The staff itself commits to carefully observe every sanitary prescription and to go to work only in the absence of any symptoms relating to Covid-19;

- To strictly and scrupulously comply, in the case of a confirmed infection with Covid-19 by a child or an adult coming or going out of the facility to the provisions of the local health authority;

- The signing of this pact commits the parties to respect it in good faith;

- From a legal point of view, it does not release those who sign it from any liability in case of non-compliance with regulations relating to the containment of the Covid-19 epidemic.
